KYOcapture is a server-based document capture workflow solution. As open-architecture middleware, it is designed to seamlessly integrate with existing or new document management systems, as a portal through which documents can travel.

Select Kyocera MFPs seamlessly capture paper-based documents, which can then be processed and routed to multiple locations. By utilizing the same devices already employed for printing and copying, Kyocera enables businesses to realize increased efficiencies in their document workflow, as well as related cost savings.

CAPTURE

- Decentralize for improved productivity – integrating the workflow process directly into the control panel of Kyocera MFP devices.

PROCESS

- Automatically convert text using optical character recognition (OCR) to simplify the process of searching archived documents.
- Convert documents to popular file formats such as PDF and XML, or improved flexibility.
- Improve quality and extract information to increase productivity.

ROUTE

- Route documents to existing or new document management systems and databases such as Documentum, Interwoven, Microsoft® Sharepoint Portal and others.
